
What is the difference between the carrier tape and the cover tape?


The cover tape and the carrier tape are two different products, and many people cannot distinguish the difference between the cover tape and the carrier tape.

Cover tape refers to a strip product used in the field of electronic packaging and used in conjunction with a carrier tape. The cover tape is usually based on a polyester or polypropylene film, and is compounded or coated with different functional layers (antistatic layer, adhesive layer, etc.), and can be sealed on the surface of the carrier tape under external force or heating to form A closed space protects the electronic components in the carrier tape.

Carrier Tape refers to a strip product used in the field of electronic packaging, which has a specific thickness, and equidistantly distributes holes (also called pockets) for receiving electronic components in the longitudinal direction thereof. Positioning hole for index positioning.
